

COOKIE AND TRACKING POLICY

Tamreen may use strictly necessary cookies, local storage, session storage, pixels, tags, device identifiers, and similar technologies to operate the Platform, secure user sessions, remember language choices, support payment flows, detect abuse, and maintain legal Consent Records.

Tamreen may also use analytics, performance, marketing, or advertising technologies only where permitted by applicable law and, where required, after the User has been given a clear choice through a cookie or tracking consent banner.

Strictly necessary technologies are used because the Platform cannot function reliably without them. Optional analytics or marketing technologies should not be activated until the User has accepted them, unless applicable law allows otherwise.

Tamreen may use service providers for hosting, security, analytics, payment processing, customer support, error monitoring, and product improvement. These providers may process technical identifiers, usage events, browser data, device data, IP address, approximate location, referral source, page views, and interaction events according to Tamreen's instructions and their applicable terms.

Users may manage browser cookies through their browser settings. Blocking necessary cookies may affect Platform functionality, login, payments, language settings, security checks, and consent records.

Where Tamreen uses optional tracking, Users should be able to accept, reject, or later change their preference where technically available. Tamreen should keep a record of cookie or tracking choices, including timestamp, version, and preference selected.

Tamreen does not use this Policy to authorize hidden tracking, sale of personal data, or sharing of sensitive Fitness and Wellness Data for advertising without appropriate notice and

consent.

This Policy should be read with the Privacy Policy, Terms and Conditions, Payment and Refund Policy, and User Consent.

Nothing in this Policy limits mandatory privacy, consumer, or electronic communications rights under Kuwait law.
